# **Budget Workshop #1 Recap**

- Projected Fund Balance for SYE 6/30/23: \$5.55M
  - Unreserved Fund Balance: \$2.57M
    - Includes an estimated \$948k for the current 2022-23 SY
  - Reserves: \$2.98M
- Executive Budget Proposal includes an increase of \$4.4M in Foundation Aid
  - Foundation aid includes a \$461k high impact tutoring set aside
  - Estimated reduction in building aid of \$710k
  - Estimated total increase of \$4.1M (Expense Driven, UPK & Building Aid)
- Maximum Tax Levy for 2023-24: \$7.7M
  - Year over year increase of 2.1%

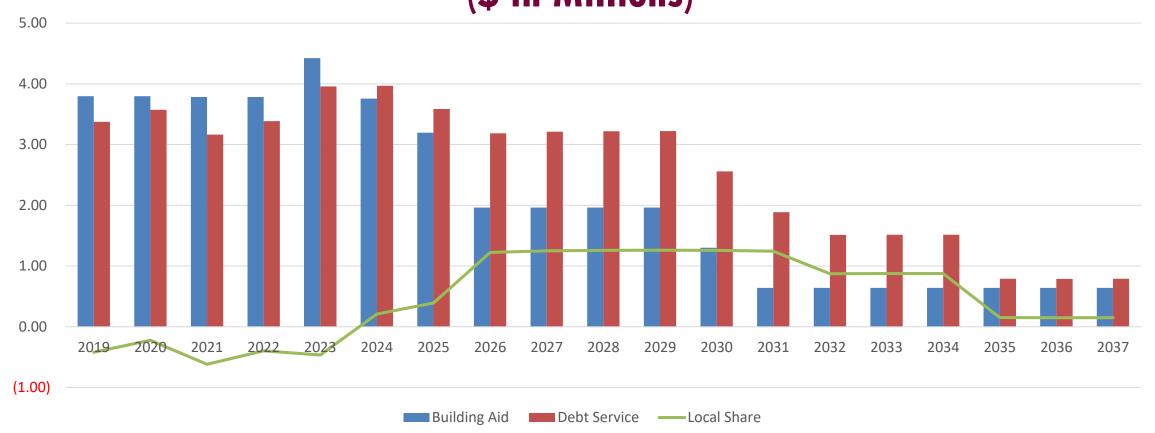
## **SY 2023-24 Budget Development**

- Holding department and building level budget meetings
- Identifying student needs in academic areas & growing subgroups
  - Exploring the length of the academic day
- Adopting regional approaches to shared services
- Examining transportation needs
- Aligning budget with remaining Federal ARPA funding
- Long-term Planning for Financing "Debt Bubble"

# **Capital Tax Levy Exclusion**

- For school districts, the local portion of capital expenditures is excludable from the tax levy limit
- Local Portion: Capital Expenditures > Building Aid
- "Debt Bubble": Beginning in the 2023-24 SY, estimated debt service will be greater than Building Aid
  - Net Expenditures are estimated to be \$1.1M over revenues beginning in 2025-26 SY
- Reserves: Currently \$2M to mitigate local share

#### Watervliet Elementary School

- 2.0 FTE Classroom LTS to maintain small class size with 5 sections of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade
- Replace 2 retiring teachers

### Watervliet Jr/Sr High School

- 1.0 FTE Special Education teacher
- Restore 1.0 FTE science teacher
- Replace 3 retiring teachers
- Alternative Learning Pathway

#### District-wide

- Potential increase of 20-30 minutes of instructional time resulting in increase of instructional salaries
- Shared 1.0 FTE ENL Teacher
- Provide mental health support with contracted services



#### Athletics

- Merge all athletics with Green Island
- Green Island to provide part-time Athletic Director
- Additional coaching positions for sports with increased student participation
  - Football, Girls Wrestling, Baseball, Softball, Cheerleading & Track

#### Curriculum & Instruction

- Update K-6 science kits to align with Next Generation Science Standards (BOCES Aidable)
- Second year of new K-8 math program payment

#### Food Service

- Provide Green Island with Breakfast, Lunch & Snack
- Increase BOCES shared service to 2.5 days per week
- Hire 2 food service workers



## Technology

- Continue one-to-one device use for all students & staff
- Replace outdated servers & classroom computers
- Hire 0.4 FTE IT support

## Transportation

- Increase contracted transportation cost for displaced students, approximately \$500,000
- Propose 5-year lease on 1 district mini-bus
- Hire a Transportation Coordinator
- Provide transportation coordination for out-of-district bus runs for Green Island



- Other
  - Potential salary increase for non-aligned employees Food Service & Maintenance Workers
  - Transfer 2 UPK program support positions to the general fund
  - Establish preventative maintenance contracts for HVAC equipment (chillers & boilers)
  - Negotiating an increase in SRO services
  - Increased security measures
  - HR support
